Step one: Discuss and examine some foundational questions about your faith:

- What is your spiritual journey & background?
- How are you feeling about your relationship with God?
- Do you believe you are in a saved relationship with God?
- What church experiences have you had?
- Do you believe in One God and that He is the God of the Bible?
- Do you have any doubts?
- Do you believe Jesus is God's son? That he rose from the dead?
- Do you have any specific concerns or questions as you begin this study?

Step two: Get a journal to write in.

Step three: Read thoughtfully and carefully each chapter.

*Keep in mind the scriptures are meant to be practiced in community rather than independently

- What are your 1st impressions?
- Are there any questions you have?
- Are there any term, place or person that you need to define?
- Discover important themes of Jesus. These questions will be helpful
 - Is Jesus' authority shown or described?
 - Is there a command I'm being called to obey?
 - Is there a promise to be trust?
 - Is there a truth to be believed?
 - Is there anything describing the characteristics of His followers?
 - How is sin described?
 - How is repentance described?
 - What am I being called to do?
