GOSPEL

- BE ALERT: over time the Gospel has been changed in small ways here and there
 - We have accepted a non discipleship gospel
 - What does this mean? A gospel of forgiveness primarily and following Jesus optionally
 - The non-discipleship gospel today includes the beliefs:
 - God exists
 - He wants people to be good and nice
 - The goal of life is to be happy and at peace with ourselves
 - God doesn't need to be involved in our life unless we have a need
 - When we die we go to heaven

SCRIPTURE READING:

- Romans 1:1-4
- 1 Corinthians 15:3-5
- 2 Timothy 2:8

GOSPEL:

- Jesus has become KING
- Christ = King (not a last name)
- The King was born, lived, died for the sins of the people and rose from the dead

EXPECTATIONS OF THE GOSPEL: (Not to get God to love us, instead BECAUSE HE LOVES US)

- Mark 1:17- FOLLOW ME and I WILL MAKE YOU FISHERS OF MEN
- What does following Jesus look like?
 - Mark 8:34-38
 - Denv Self (continually)
 - Take up cross (continually)
 - Matthew 28:18-20
 - All Authority (KING!!) therefore:
 - Go make disciples...(HOW?)
 - Baptize them INTO THE NAME OF JESUS (Transfer ownership)
 - Teach them to obey everything I have commanded

BENEFITS OF THE GOSPEL:

- The benefits of the gospel (Make certain we aren't turning the benefits into the heart of the gospel)
 - Ephesians 1: Adoption, purpose, acceptance
 - Acts 2: Forgiveness of Sin & Holy Spirit
 - Luke 4:18/Galatians 5:1- Freedom from sin, bondage
 - Romans 6: NEW LIFE....

THE GOSPEL FREES US FROM A PERFORMANCE BASED RELIGION

Christianity generally is practiced in a couple of different ways.

Both of these fool us into a lifeless, burdened style of religion that is simply one big chore:

• God doesn't really like me or approve of me. I must do good things to get close to Him

OR

• I need God to make my life good and easy. If I say certain things and do certain things he will give me good things.

The gospel says that just doing good things isn't what makes him like you, in fact he loved you and me when we were in complete rebellion to him. How would this fact change the way we follow Jesus?

DISCIPLESHIP

WHAT IS A DISCIPLE OF JESUS?

- Someone who has decided to die to self and live to follow Jesus
- Someone being changed by Jesus (moving on to maturity)
- Someone who is on a mission to make other disciples
- See Matthew 4:19

WHAT IS DISCIPLESHIP?

- The practical day to day learning, living and transformation as a student of Jesus
- See Matthew 4:19

JESUS' TEACHING METHODS ARE SIMPLE

- Feed on the word of God
 - John 1:1-5
 - John 1:14
 - John 6:35-51
- · Obey the word of God
 - 1 John 5:1-5
 - James 1:22-25
 - Do you read the bible with obedience in mind?
- DISCIPLESHIP IS INTENDED FOR COMMUNITY NOT ISOLATION
 - Acts 2:42-47
 - 1 Corinthians 12:12-26
- DID THE EARLY CHRISTIANS BELIEVE THIS?
 - 2 Timothy 3:16-17
 - Hebrews 4:12-13
- If we are not feasting on His word we have virtually no chance to obey Him
- THE BEAUTY OF JESUS 'CALLING is that it is meant to be lived out where we live, where we work and where we play
- IF YOU HAVEN'T YET begin building some healthy spiritual habits
 - Daily Bible Study
 - Daily Prayer
 - Daily interaction with others from the CFC

 - Must repent of self-lordship
 - Follow Jesus
 - Be transformed by Jesus
 - Help others become his disciples
- Baptize in the name of Jesus
 - Acts 2:36-40
 - Romans 6:1-11
- Walk with people teaching them to obey everything Jesus commanded
 - One another well: Colossians 3:16

PRINCIPLES OF DISCIPLE MAKING

- Specific humble prayer
 - Father, allow us to join you in the work you are already doing
 - Father, lead me to people of peace (Luke 10:1-12)
- Must be able to proclaim the gospel in plain language
 - If being a disciple isn't good news to you, it won't be for anyone else
- Must get to know people's starting point. (Acts 8:35)
 - Someone striving to follow Jesus (Apollos)
 - Someone who doesn't profess Christianity at all
 - Someone who is familiar with Christianity but not living it out.

THE PRACTICE OF HOSPITALITY

- This includes opening your home to others
- This includes inviting friends, family, neighbors to any and all CFC activities
 - · We always have room for another chair at the table
- This includes being warm and welcoming to any and all people joining us
- Must love God and people!
 - 1 Corinthians 13:1-3
- Walk with them.
 - CONSISTENCY is crucial. Set aside time each week to study the Bible
 - PRAY TOGETHER
 - MODEL life. (Know and be known)
