



WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?:

- The announcement to the world that Jesus is KING and His Kingdom is available
- Christ = Anointed one. Messiah (not a last name)
- The King was born, lived, died for the sins of the people and rose from the dead

BENEFITS OF THE GOSPEL:

- The benefits of the gospel are oftentimes what most people are taught as the gospel
- Ephesians 1: Adoption, purpose, acceptance
- Acts 2: Forgiveness of Sin & Holy Spirit
- John 3:3-8: Entrance into HIS Kingdom
- Luke 4:18/Galatians 5:1- Freedom from sin, bondage
- Romans 6: NEW LIFE....

EXPECTATIONS OF THE GOSPEL: (Not to get God to love us, instead BECAUSE HE LOVES US)

- Mark 1:17- FOLLOW ME and I WILL MAKE YOU FISHERS OF MEN
 - The expectation is we would follow Him as His apprentice understanding that He is teaching us and transforming us to do what He does
 - What does following Jesus look like?
 - Mark 8:34-38
 - Deny Self (continually)
 - Take up cross (continually)
 - Matthew 28:18-20
 - All Authority (KING!!) therefore:
 - Go make disciples...(HOW?)
 - Baptize them INTO THE NAME OF JESUS (Transfer ownership)
 - Teach them to obey everything I have commanded

GOSPEL PRINCIPLES

- We aren't trying to do good things to get God to like us (He already loves us completely)
- We aren't trying to do good things to get things from Him

DISCIPLESHIP

WHAT IS A DISCIPLE OF JESUS?

- Someone who has decided to die to self and live to follow Jesus
- Someone being changed and re-aligned by Jesus (moving on to maturity)
- · Someone who is on a mission to make other disciples
- See Matthew 4:19

WHAT IS DISCIPLESHIP?

- Apprenticeship to Jesus: The practical day to day learning, living and transformation as a student of Jesus
- Philippians 2:1-11 Becoming a servant to all

• JESUS' TEACHING METHODS ARE SIMPLE

- Feed on the word of God
 - John 1:1-5
 - John 1:14
 - John 6:35-51
- Obey the word of God
 - 1 John 5:1-5
 - James 1:22-25
 - Do you read the bible with obedience in mind?
- Practice what He practiced
 - Prayer
 - Service
 - Silence/Solitude

• THE PRINCIPLE OF WALKING IN THE LIGHT IS CRUCIAL

- 1 John 1:5-10
- James 5:13-20

DISCIPLESHIP IS INTENDED FOR COMMUNITY NOT ISOLATION

- Acts 2:42-47
- 1 Corinthians 12:12-26
- THE BEAUTY OF JESUS ' CALLING is that it is meant to be lived out where we live, where we work and where we play

• IT REQUIRES REFLECTION, COURAGE AND INTENTION

- Are you prepared to be honest about yourself?
- Are you eager to be re-aligned towards Jesus? (His ways & character)
- Are you prepared to make a daily commitment to be an apprentice of Jesus?

- Acts 2:42-47

- Romans 12:1-21

- Rejecting consumeristic Christianity by
 - Living together as missionaries
 - Intentionally participating in group gatherings
 - Striving to know others and to be known by others

Teach Jesus is King

- Matthew 28:18-20
- Matthew 7:21- We must want the will of god to be done, not just doing spiritual things
- Matthew 4:17-20
 - Must repent of self-lordship
 - Follow Jesus
 - Be transformed by Jesus
 - Help others become his disciples
- Baptize in the name of Jesus
 - Acts 2:36-40
 - Romans 6:1-11
 - John 3:3-8 (Born Again)
- Walk with people teaching them to obey everything Jesus commanded • One another well: Colossians 3:16

PRINCIPLES OF DISCIPLE MAKING

• Specific humble prayer

- Father, allow us to join you in the work you are already doing
- Father, lead me to people of peace (Luke 10:1-12)
- Must be able to proclaim the gospel in plain language
 - If being a disciple isn't good news to you, it won't be for anyone else
- Must get to know people's starting point. (Acts 8:35)
 - Someone striving to follow Jesus (Apollos)
 - Someone who doesn't profess Christianity at all
 - Someone who is familiar with Christianity but not living it out.

THE PRACTICE OF HOSPITALITY

- This includes opening your home to others
- This includes inviting friends, family, neighbors to any and all CFC activities
 We always have room for another chair at the table
- This includes being warm and welcoming to any and all people joining us
- Must love God and people! (1 Corinthians 13:1-3)
- Walk with them.
 - CONSISTENCY is crucial. Set aside time each week to study the Bible
 - PRAY TOGETHER
 - MODEL life. (Know and be known)
